WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2005 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir from Sonoma Stage Vineyard is our second vintage of Pinot from this site. The vineyard lies in a very cool area with significant marine influence providing relatively low average temperatures and a great deal of cloud cover. The marginal climate, small berry size, and clonal blend (Calera and Swan Clone) present us with an incredibly interesting Pinot Noir with many layers. As with the 2004, we see the signature intense wild strawberry and raspberry as well as floral hints, and smoky notes of tar and earth. The palate has ample weight balanced by a pleasing natural acidity, and finishes with silky tannins and smooth texture.
